

## **ELIZABETH BURGESS - *Piano***

Elizabeth Burgess is a pianist dedicated to the fields of song and chamber music. She has recently appeared in recital at the Wigmore Hall, St John's Smith Square, the Aldeburgh and Buxton Festivals, and is an alumnus of both *Young Songmakers' Almanac* and the *Britten-Pears Young Artist Scheme*. Born in Sussex, Elizabeth studied at Christ Church, Oxford (as organ scholar) and the Royal Academy of Music. Here she performed with the Academy's prestigious Song Circle, won numerous accompaniment prizes, and was awarded the coveted DipRAM for her final recital in 2009.

Part of the first-prize-winning duo of the Wigmore Hall International and Chelsea Schubert Festival Song Competitions 2009, she has since broadcast several times on Radio 3 and has given recitals throughout the UK. Increasingly in demand as a vocal coach, Elizabeth held the inaugural Lucille Graham Opera Fellowship at the Royal Academy of Music (2010-2011), conducted the 2010 Ryedale Festival Opera productions, and was chorusmaster for the 2011 world premiere of Peter Maxwell Davies' *Kommilitonen!*. She is currently a Samling Scholar, holds the Shinn Fellowship at RAM, and is on the keyboard staff at Eton College.
